

**Theodore Roosevelt Council  
Boy Scouts of America - Insurance Claim  
Massapequa, New York**



HE2PD served as Program Managers overseeing the building of a new 7,100sf Dining Hall at the Schiff Scouting Reservation. The new facility replaced a building lost in a 2011 fire at the Boy Scout Camp. In addition to Program Management Services, HE2PD acted as the representative for the Theodore Roosevelt Council (TRC) in its dealings with the insurance company, which resulted in a substantial increase in the insurance settlement that the camp received to rebuild the structure.

The new Dining Hall houses a 3,500sf dining room, an 1,800sf commercial kitchen, handicapped restrooms and storage room. The dining room features an 18ft high custom climbing wall. All permitting, Pine Barrens approvals, DOH and DEP inspections and approvals were managed by our firm on behalf of TRC.

HE2PD was commissioned to oversee the upgrades of the 1,400 acre Onteora Campsite and the 400 acre Schiff Scouting Reservation. This included upgrades to the infrastructure, along with renovations to buildings throughout the camps.
